2. BIBLE TIME

READ:

- Matthew 27:62-28:10

MAIN POINT:

One of the core beliefs of Christianity is that Jesus Christ has risen from the dead. According to Romans 10:9, believing in the resurrection of Jesus is what causes us to get saved, so how do we know that His resurrection really happened? We know from secular and Biblical history that Jesus lived about 2,000 years ago. Jesus ministered for three years, was arrested and crucified by the Romans. Almost everyone agrees with these facts. Christians, however, believe that not only did Jesus die on the cross, but that He rose from the dead. If Jesus did rise from the dead, then it proves that He is the Son of God.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

1. Why did Pilate command the tomb be sealed? (people thought Jesus' disciples would steal his body)
2. Why were Martha and Mary afraid? (they thought Jesus was a ghost)
3. Why is Easter a special day? (celebration of Jesus raising from the dead)

3. FAMILY TIME

MAIN POINT:

Jesus died on the cross and He rose from the dead.

WHAT YOU NEED:

- A snack for everyone.
- Play several games of Hide-N-Seek.
- When finished, gather everyone for their snack.

DISCUSS:

- Talk about how much fun it was looking for everyone and trying to find them.
- The Bible talks about Martha and Mary trying to find Jesus after He was crucified.

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

1. Why couldn't Martha and Mary find Jesus? (He was not there)
2. Where did Jesus go? (He rose from the dead and was resurrected)
3. What does resurrected mean? (someone coming back to life after death)
